WHEREAS, the efforts of these military health care professionals continue to be the United States military's and Air Force Global Strike Command's best defense against this frightening pandemic; and

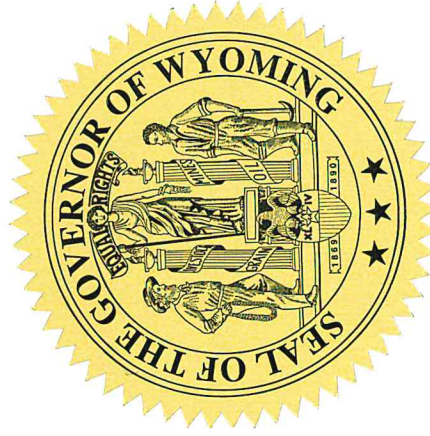
