How to run a Tuesday Tables

The idea is simple, on a Tuesday, residents are encouraged to put out a box of items they no longer need for people to take for free. This is building upon behaviour we have seen in lockdown with many people doing this by their own volition. It can be anything as long as it's clean, not broken and nothing dangerous.

It is hoped that the event will become a regular occurrence in the community that people will just do. To start with, this needs someone to help promote it locally and this is easily done via social media, press releases and newsletters.

With covid restrictions meaning that charity shops are overwhelmed with donations, this is an easy way of preventing usable items being disposed of.
