Service user reference group – volunteers wanted

Devon County Council, in collaboration with Devon NHS organisations, is hosting a Reshaping Personal Care Group (part of the Living Well at Home project) to help design a new way for personal care to be delivered to people.

Healthwatch has been helping us to identify service users with lived experience of paid care and carers to be part of this.

We are also asking service providers to speak to their service users and see if anyone would be interested in being nominated to be part of this group. We also welcome members of the Proud to Care group including the Health and Social Care forum who may wish to represent service users / carers interests.

Ideally the group needs to include as wide a representation of service users as possible, including people of differing ages, ethnicity, sexuality and gender, as well people with experience of specific needs related to, for example, learning disability, long term conditions, physical and sensory impairments, mental health problems and ageing.
