This year we have topics including a young persons perspective on the Care System, advice on Self harm, Going Missing, Transitioning to independence, Adoption, coping with loss, CSE and Communication..

Takeover is a November event but following a very successful event with the staff we are rolling it out to carers during Fostering fortnight to give you an insight of how our young people feel.
