From now on, a child pass will cover <u>any</u> child a foster carer registered for Devon takes into the park. The new flexibility means that a child annual pass can continue to used for the next child when a child moves on or returns home, before the year ends. Really useful, especially for those that do respite and have different children frequently.

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING YOUR TAX RETURN IS 31ST OCTOBER SO DON'T DELAY!

Tax - General guidance on fostering and tax can be found on HMRC website, https://www.gov.uk/foster-carers/help-with-the-cost-of-fostering , but carers are <u>STRONGLY advised</u> to check their own individual personal circumstances carefully.

National Insurance Contributions - To ensure you receive the benefit of Class 2 National Insurance credits when you retire, you will need to have at hand a copy of a letter from Childrens' Services confirming how long you've been caring for Devon. – ask your supervising social worker for one now! Don't miss out
