THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING YOUR TAX RETURN

IS 31ST OCTOBER SO DON'T DELAY!

Tax - General guidance on fostering and tax can be found on HMRC website, https://www.gov.uk/foster-carers/help-with-the-cost-of-fostering, but carers are STRONGLY advised to check their own individual personal circumstances carefully.

National Insurance Contributions - To ensure you receive the benefit of Class 2 National Insurance credits when you retire, you will need to have at hand a copy of a letter from Childrens' Services confirming how long you've been caring for Devon. — ask your supervising social worker for one now!
