

FOSTERING NETWORK - CAMPAIGN

Did you know that **fostered children** in England are being **denied** 15 hours free childcare that's been available to all other children since September 2017? All other children in England are now entitled to up to 30 hours a week of free childcare. This exclusion is discriminatory and inexplicable. We all know that our foster children will thrive when surrounded by, and given equal opportunities as, their peers. These early years before school are crucial to their development. This Government and previous Governments have all encouraged people to foster by saying that fostering can be combined with working outside the home, but foster carers often have to pay for the additional 15 hours out of their own pockets, or enter into difficult negotiations with their fostering service. We all know that foster carers are already under immense financial pressure, with barely 10 per cent earning the equivalent of the national living wage for a 40-hour week.

If you want to help, write to your MP and make them aware - take action by writing to your MP and asking them to raise it with the children's minister, Robert Goodwill. To find your MP, simply log onto https://www.writetothem.com/ and follow the simple instructions. Then, simply click on your MP's name, write your message and send.
