Script:

Hello, my name is _____ and I'm (*whatever title the person wants*). In a few moments, you will see a video of me receiving my COVID-19 vaccine. It doesn't matter which arm you receive the vaccine in but the suggestion is to get it in the arm you don't use to write as there can be soreness where the vaccine is given.

My side effects were _____. Some people who receive the vaccine may also experience headaches, a sore arm, or other symptoms of the flu. This is normal and means the vaccine is doing its job to protect you from COVID-19. In very rare cases, a person might have a severe allergic. If this happens, please call 911 for immediate medical care.

I decided to get vaccinated to protect myself, my family, and our community from COVID-19. I will continue to wear a mask, practice social distance, and wash my hands. I am hopeful that as more people get vaccinated and follow COVID-19 guidelines we will get the pandemic under control.
