

Adult Long Term Care Functional Screen (LTCFS) Diagnoses Cue Sheet—Summary of Changes 2023 Update

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) updated the [LTCFS Diagnoses Cue Sheet](#) on August 29, 2023. This summary of changes includes major changes made, along with new entries.

DHS removed the preamble from the cue sheet. The information found in the preamble will be included in the LTCFS instructions, to be published late 2023. The cue sheet will be available as an Excel spreadsheet only. DHS encourages screeners to use the cue sheet electronically instead of printing a copy so they can use the “Control + F” search feature. Also, screeners are encouraged to use the cue sheet and not solely rely on what is on the Diagnoses Table—there may be more information to help code correctly on the cue sheet than on the Diagnoses Table.
